Directions: Work all cross stitches according to chart and color/stitch key. Then work leaf stitches and Double Cross Eyelet according to stitch diagram. Sew on beads using thread to match fabric or bead.

Finishing: Count out 18 threads from each point of design area. Score and then cut away excess fabric. Fold the keep in half horizontally (right sides together) and stitch across each side 8 threads in from the edge. Turn keep right side out. Fold under eight threads along unfinished edge (toward inside). Make twisted cord from silk (or use purchased ribbon). Fold in half and knot at ends. Insert knotted end into opening of keep and begin to whip stitch opening together. Leave a small area unstitched at the bottom of the keep. Fill keep with emery grains or....use rice. After filling, finish whip stitching the opening together. Loop cord through scissors.
